CIRCULAR ECONOMY: As one of the Earth's natural renewable resources, KBH guarantees its gold is always 100% recycled and reclaimed 14k or 18k solid gold, no vermeil, never filled or newly mined. KBH adheres to The New Gold Standard avoiding the harmful effects of metal mining – arsenic, mercury and lead pollution. Going further to ensure ethical business practices, KBH actively partners with Mercury Free Mining Challenge and Earthworks.

SUSTAINABILITY PURPOSE: With Planet-first jewellery as its mantra, KBH believes investment worthy pieces should be luxe and sustainably made without need to compromise on either.
